1. Subject of the procedure

This document establishes the regulations for using the French collective mark "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" registered by the SGDSN¹.

The ANSSI is attached to the Secrétaire général de la défense et de la sécurité nationale and therefore manages the mark.

Throughout this document, the term "product" will denote either a product, a system, a protection profile or a site.

2. The "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark

The "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark is a collective, semi-figurative mark, composed of the logo integrating "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION".

It is reproduced below:



The "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark is a logo intended to be placed on documents related to product certification.

On behalf of the French government, the ANSSI grants the right to use the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" collective certification mark to people who order and develop evaluations as a certification mark for their products certified under amended decree No. 2002-535 of 18th April 2002 relating to the evaluation and certification of the security provided by information technology products and systems (certification under Common Criteria, ITSEC² or CSPN³).

3. Ownership of the mark

The "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark, registered at the INPI under the number 02 3 175 658, is the exclusive property of the French Government represented by the SGDSN from its deposit at the INPI for France.

4. Marking rules

4.1. Graphic charter

The "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark is added in colour:

- orange (Pantone 158) and black letters;
- 10% black background.

The mark may be used in colour (white, orange, grey and black) according to the graphic charter in chapter 2, or in black and white / shades of grey as shown below.

4.2. Usage dimension

For paper documentation, two extreme sizes are authorised:



Maximum size 1 (Width: 3.3 cm; height: 3.5 cm) rectangular shape



Minimum size 1 (Width: 1.4 cm; height: 1.5 cm) rectangular shape

For applying to products, the size may be adapted according to the product. In any case, the ratio between the height and the width must be maintained.

5. Usage conditions

Any reproduction of the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark must respect the requirements in the graphic charter (colour references in particular).

The use of the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark is only authorised under the conditions set by these general rules to which the holders of a usage right commit to respect.

Only the usage right holder may apply the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark in accordance with the usage modes defined below.

6. Certification mark usage

The ANSSI applies the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark to the following documents:

- CC, ITSEC and CSPN certificates;
- CC, ITSEC and CSPN certification reports;
- Maintenance reports;
- Monitoring reports;
- Certification body quality system documents (in particular quality manual, procedures, instructions, application notes);
- The ANSSI website;
- Any documents linked to the previous elements.

The ANSSI grants the right to use the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark according to the following provisions:

- By the ITSEFs⁴ on the intermediate and final technical evaluation reports;
- By the people who request or develop certified products on the commercial and technical documents linked to the certified product and on the product itself under the following conditions:
 - o Only the certified or maintained version of the product (under the procedures "ANSSI-CC-MAI-P-01" and "ANSSI-CSPN-MAI-P-01", published on the ANSSI institutional site, www.ssi.gouv.fr) may claim the certification mark;
 - o A product under surveillance, for which surveillance is stopped, may no longer claim the certification mark;
 - o The mark must be applied to as to identify clearly and unambiguously for the client the certified product, if several products or several versions of the product appear on the document.

Any other use of the certification mark by the person making the request or the ITSEF of a certified product must first be approved by the ANSSI.

7. Prohibited use of the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark

Any use of the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark other than the uses described in chapter 6 are prohibited without prior agreement from the ANSSI.

8. ANSSI rights in the event of violation of these regulations by holders of the mark usage rights

Any use of the "Ti SÉCURITÉ CERTIFICATION" mark which does not comply with these usage rules and the specified provisions and/or unauthorised use engages the usage right holder's responsibility and may lead to:

- The request for corrective actions within a fixed period of time;
- The immediate suspension of the usage right;
- The immediate withdrawal of the usage right, without prejudice to any legal proceedings and requests for reparation of the prejudice incurred by the ANSSI or the French Government due to this failure.
